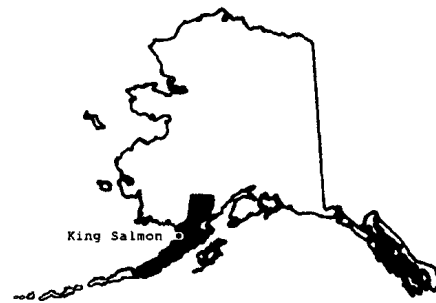

A RESOLUTION OF THE LAKE AND PENINSULA SCHOOL BOARD PROMOTING STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SAFETY PROGRAMS
