Holiday Tutoring

BHS hired 3 staff to assist with holiday tutoring for all students who were failing or struggling with their studies. The schedule was for 8 days 8-3pm. A total of 116 total attended (daily average of 14).

Student Success Agents

Through the Gear Up program, the Students Success Agency is available for all BHS students. 83 students attended the kick off in November and 51 of those students signed up with an agent (61%). These agents give support, and advice with college applications, goals, and academic.

Core Recovery Classes & Night Class & Odysseyware

BHS offers the opportunity to make up credits for core classes students did not pass in the previous years. BHS uses Odysseyware to accomplish this task. In the school year 19-20, BHS had 5 class sections available; during 1st semester 37 classes were recovered, and during 2nd semester 58 classes were recovered. In 20-21, BHS is offering 3 sections, although 1st semester is not finished, we already have 20 classes recovered. This school year we have implemented Night School, utilizing 2 teachers. Night school for credit recovery students is scheduled after the school day and utilizes Odysseyware as well. There are 14 students enrolled and 2 students are close to recovering their credits.

Asynchronous Learning Time & Friday School

To assist with failing classes and students needing extra help BHS will be having all students stay in google meets during the asynchronous time. This will help to ensure students get help and assignments are completed. Starting Friday any student failing class must attend Friday school. Notes were sent home to parents and students to notify them of these changes.

AISA Grant

In December BHS was notified they received a grant from the American Indian Student Achievement Unit at OPI for \$45,000 to boost graduation rates. This grant will hire 10 student mentors, Student support coordinator (once approved), provide mentor training, and comprehensive student transcript review & analysis process. The transcript review and analysis were completed and BHS has some great processes in place to make sure all students receive the correct credits.

Graduation Information

BHS has 96 seniors and BHA has 36 seniors listed on the Senior rosters. With BHS/BHA having the ability to graduate with 4 different tracks of diplomas, we are meeting with seniors daily to update our credit lists and starting the list for graduation. Ms. Bullshoe has been in touch with both students and parents at BHS on graduation requirements, scholarship information and is working with GEAR UP

on FAFSA applications. Diploma covers have been ordered. We are in the process of ordering paper for programs, awards events, and gifts for parents/gifts.

Graduation this year is May 23, 2021 11:00am-BHS will plan for virtual (somewhat like last year), inside and outside (on the new sports field maybe).
