

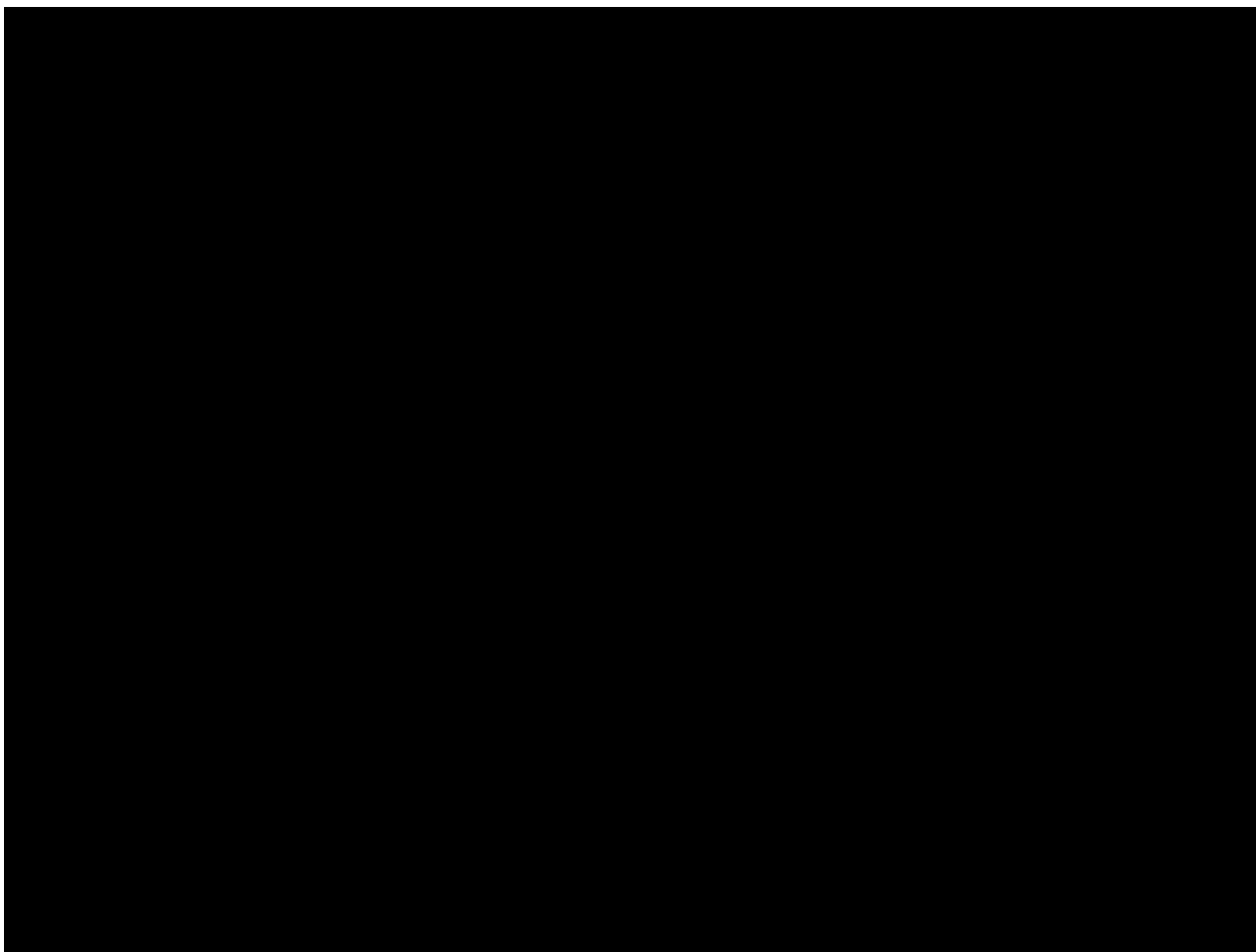

- Yearly recap:
- 6,801 total open gym participants, 1,162 adult enrichment participants (unique users).
- A Driver Discount Program for adults ages 55+ is offered in conjunction with SCSU and Precision Driving Center, participants completing the course save money on auto insurance.
- Favorite classes last year included pickleball, line dancing, and cooking!

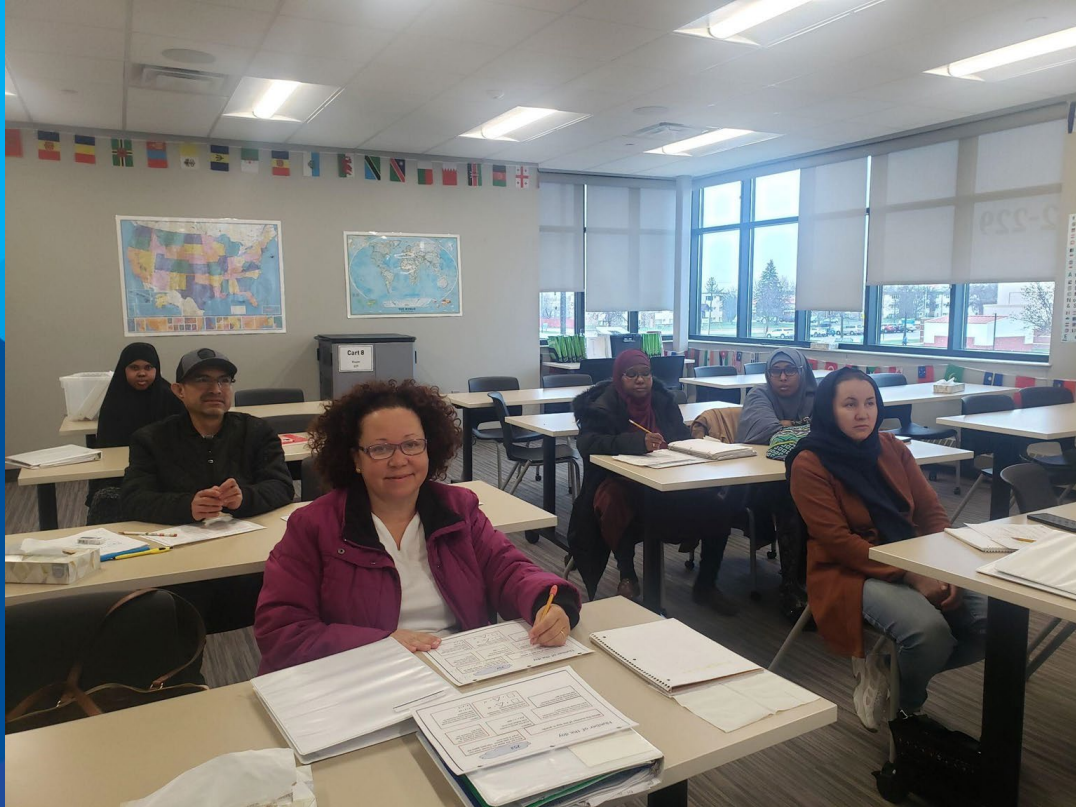

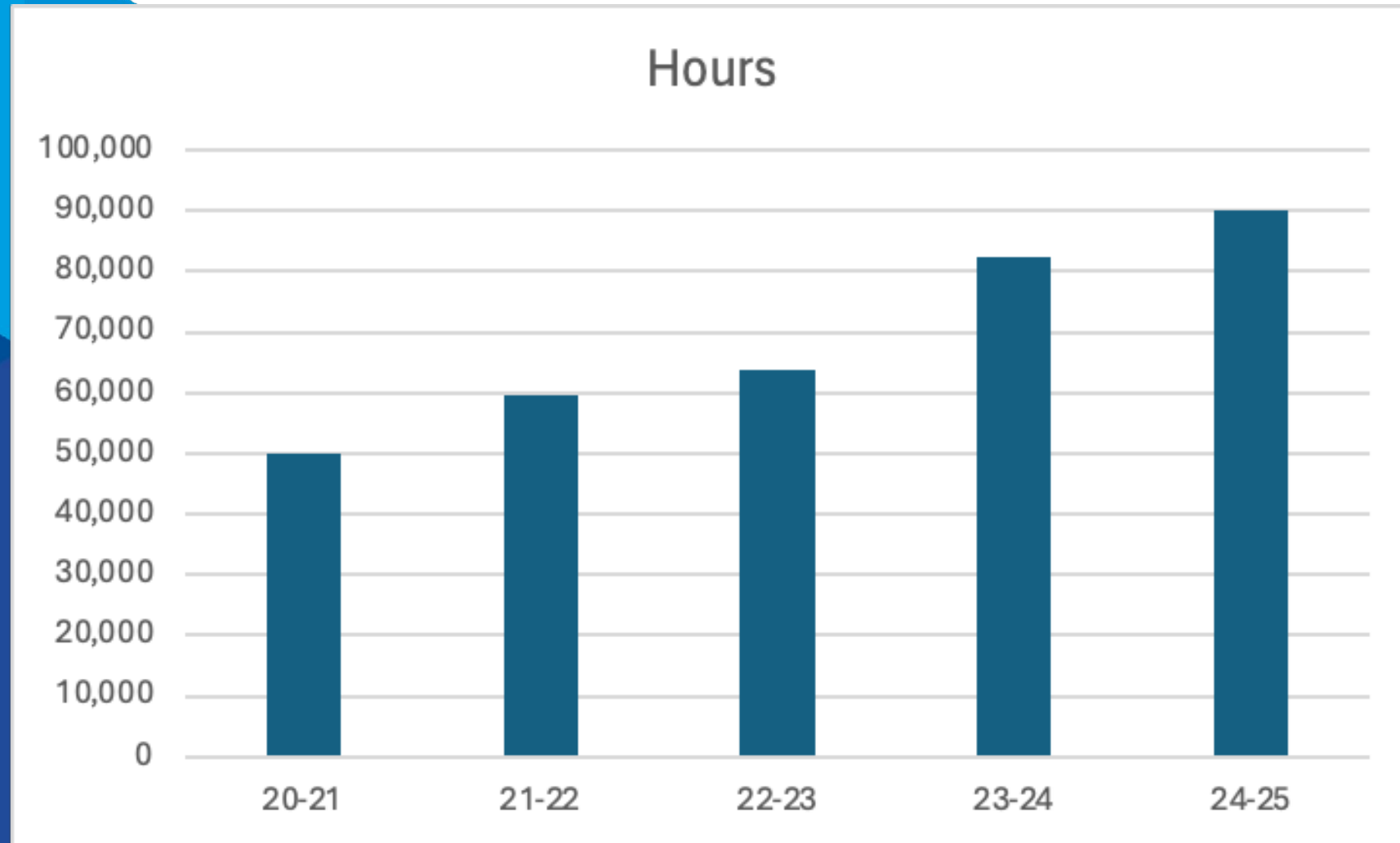
2025 School Climate Survey
