Background Information: In accordance with Board Policy CH(LOCAL), the Transportation Department is requesting authorization to purchase one Collins DH400 Chevrolet 14-passenger minibus from Longhorn Bus Sales through the BuyBoard purchasing cooperative. The minibus will support student transportation needs and provide greater flexibility for small-group travel, extracurricular activities, and specialized student transportation services.

The total purchase price for the vehicle is \$114,487. Funding for the purchase is available within approved Transportation bond funds.
