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Pricing Definitions – Bix Produce

Repack Fees:

Tomatoes that are repacked by Distributor will have a 10% shrink and a \$1.50 per case repack fee added to the Cost before applying the final Mark-Up.

Ripening Fees:

Ripened Avocados will have a \$1.50 per case ripening fee added to the Cost before adding the final Mark-Up.

(These above fees are included in the final invoice price to the district and are in addition to the overall program mark-up offered.)

<u>Sell Price Formula (Split Case</u>): formula to account for additional labor to split a case. The following example is for illustration only and does not necessarily represent actual costs.

((Cost + Freight + Fixed Fee Per Case)/Case Break) + Split Case Fixed Fee Per Case = Sell Price Split Case Fixed Fee Per Case Example: Cost \$10.00, Freight \$3.00, Fixed Fee Markup \$3.50m, Case Break ½, Split Case Fixed Fee Per Case \$2.00 Sell Price: ((\$10.00 + \$3.00 + \$3.50) / 2) + \$2.00 = \$10.25

<u>Fresh Cut Processed Produce:</u> formula to account for infrastructure used to process Fresh Cut products. The following example is for illustration only and does not necessarily represent actual costs

((Cost + Freight) / Yield) + (Labor + Packaging + Overhead + Fixed Fee Per Case) = Sell Price Fresh Cut Processed Produce Example: Cost \$10.00, Freight \$3.00, Yield 80%, Labor \$0.20, Packaging \$0.05, Overhead \$0.10, Fixed Fee Per Case \$3.50 Sell Price = ((\$10.00+\$3.00) / 80%) = \$16.25 + \$0.20 + \$0.05 + \$0.10 + \$3.50 = \$20.10

NOTE:

Our Cost of a Goods may include a rebate, promotion or other cost incentive ("Allowance") that are paid by our growers/suppliers/shippers (together called "Suppliers"). With respect to Bixcontracted goods and freight, Distributor may collect Supplier Allowances directly from its Suppliers, and Distributor will retain such Supplier Allowances. Given the significant number of Suppliers Bix utilizes and its use of a FIFO method of inventory management, it isn't operationally practical to net allowances available from Bix's Cost of Goods when calculating the net per pound or per ounce distributor price. Instead, the mark-up added to distributor cost in determining the net price in any "market basket form" is adjusted downward to account for the distributor's retention of any Supplier Allowances as well as other market realities. Setting aside operational complications, deducting the Allowances from the Cost of Goods would result in an upward change to the expressed Mark-up.
