Rental Fee: \$3,500

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Playing Surface: Our field turf surface provides an excellent playing surface with a great drainage system to keep the field in good conditions under any weather.

Dressing Rooms: Dressing rooms for both the home and visitor teams. Each side has showers, coaches' locker room, and a training area for taping. Visitor dressing rooms are located at the junior high.

2 Restrooms: Restrooms are located on the north end of the stadium, along with a family restroom which is located on both the home and visitor side.

Concession Stands: Large Concession stand located on the north end of the stadium for both the home and visitor teams.

Competing Schools Must:

- Secure all game officials
- Provide game programs and program sellers
- Provide SISD Athletic Office with a copy of the pre-game sales report and number of complimentary tickets
- Provide SISD with a copy of all game passes to be honored
- Sign and return stadium use contract
- Provide copy of rosters by Tuesday prior to game day to sflores@smithvilleisd.org
- Provide a copy of school liability insurance with SISD named as the third party

STADIUM POLICIES

Dressing Rooms:

1. Open 2 ½ hours before game time.
2. SISD will not provide towels for post-game showers.
3. SISD is not responsible for anything left in the dressing rooms before, after, or during games.

Sideline/Field Access:

1. Uniformed football players, coaches, trainers, cheerleaders, sponsors and band members do not need a sideline pass.
2. Each team will be issued 5 sideline passes. Additional passes must be requested from the Superintendent.
3. **Fans/Parents WILL NOT be allowed on the field before or after the game.**

Press Box:

1. Press box will be open 90 minutes prior to game time.
2. Boxes provide for Home Coaches/Visitor Coaches/Media Box (Seat 4)/Announcer and Score Keepers Box

Ticket Booth and Gates:

1. Gates will open 90 minutes before game time.
2. NO in and out privileges-ticket will be required for each entry.
3. NO outside food, beverages, containers, pets, backpacks, balls, or bikes, may be brought into the stadium.

Playing Field – Field Turf Surface

Welcome to Tiger Stadium. The rules below are part of our plan to ensure a high quality facility for many years to come. Head coaches, lead sponsors, and/or authorized signers of

the facility use form, will be responsible for ensuring that everyone in their group are made aware of and adheres to the rules set forth by the Smithville Independent School District. Failure to abide by these rules may result in suspensions and/or revocation of the group's ability to use the complex.

The rules and guidelines for the stadium are as follows:

1. Each school may have run-through signs that may be used only at the beginning of games and at the beginning of the second half. Spirit signs will be limited to each team's side, may not obstruct the view of fans, and may not be made out of paper. The signs must be removed immediately.
2. Do not leave any trash on the turf or track surfaces. Tape, water/soda bottles, cups, clothes, etc... Please use the provided trash receptacles.
3. No food, gum or sunflower seeds on the track surface or turf. No sports drinks, sodas, or any other drinks are allowed. Water is the ONLY beverage allowed on the track surface or turf.
4. No glass of any kind is allowed inside the complex.
5. No canopies, tents, lawn chairs, or anything that requires staking, are allowed on the track surface or turf.
6. No tobacco or vaping – this is a violation of Smithville ISD policy and Texas state law.
7. No pets are allowed on the track surface or turf.
8. Only authorized motorized vehicles are allowed on the track surface and turf (I.E. ambulance, trainer's vehicle).
9. Only authorized gas-powered machinery are allowed on the track surface or turf. A power generator and DC source may be placed on the field or turf only with special permission and only when a protective barrier is utilized between the power unit and the track surface and turf. Whenever possible, the machinery/power source will be placed on the outside of the track surface and turf. All power cords must be contained safely within close proximity to the equipment being used.
10. No live mascots, cannons, noisemakers, confetti, pyrotechnics, fireworks or flames of any kind on the track surface or turf. Fireworks and pyrotechnics are prohibited on ALL school properties.
11. Only rubber soled shoes and USATF/IAAF certified track shoes may be worn on the track surface. Only grass cleats or rubber molded cleats may be worn on the turf.
12. No sharp, jagged, edgy, heavy or damaging materials are to be used or placed on the track surface or turf.
13. Follow all state, federal and local laws and policies.

Again, we appreciate you visiting Tiger Stadium. Please remind everyone within your group that these rules will be strictly enforced. Thanks for your help and please enjoy Tiger Stadium safely. Tiger Pride!
