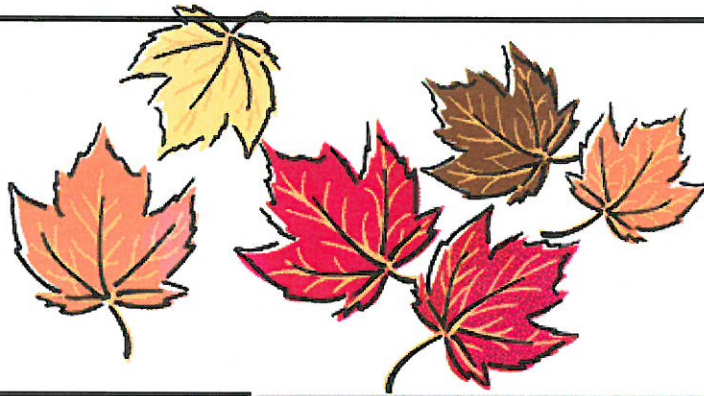




FUNDRAISER UPDATE

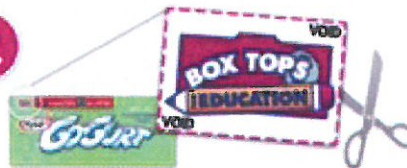

Oregon Battle of the Books

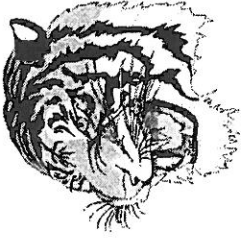

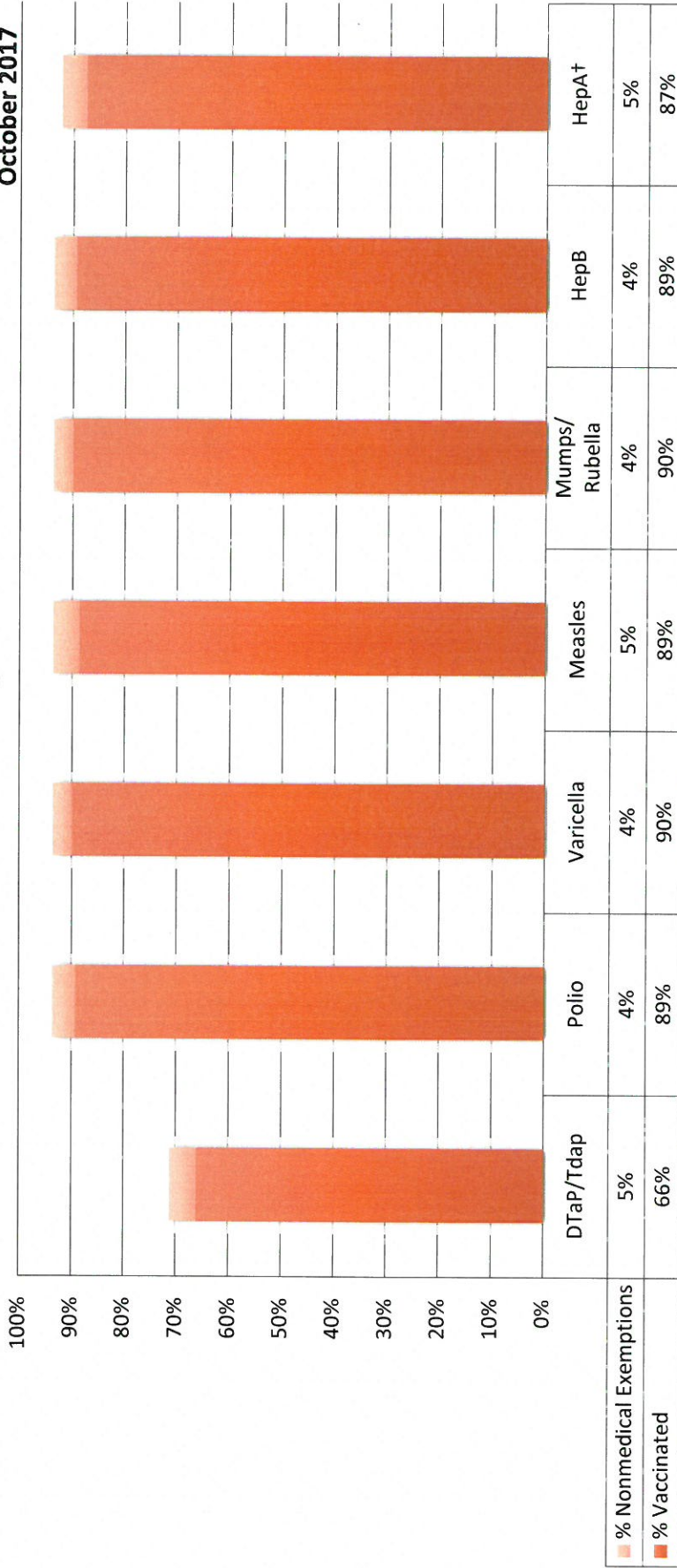

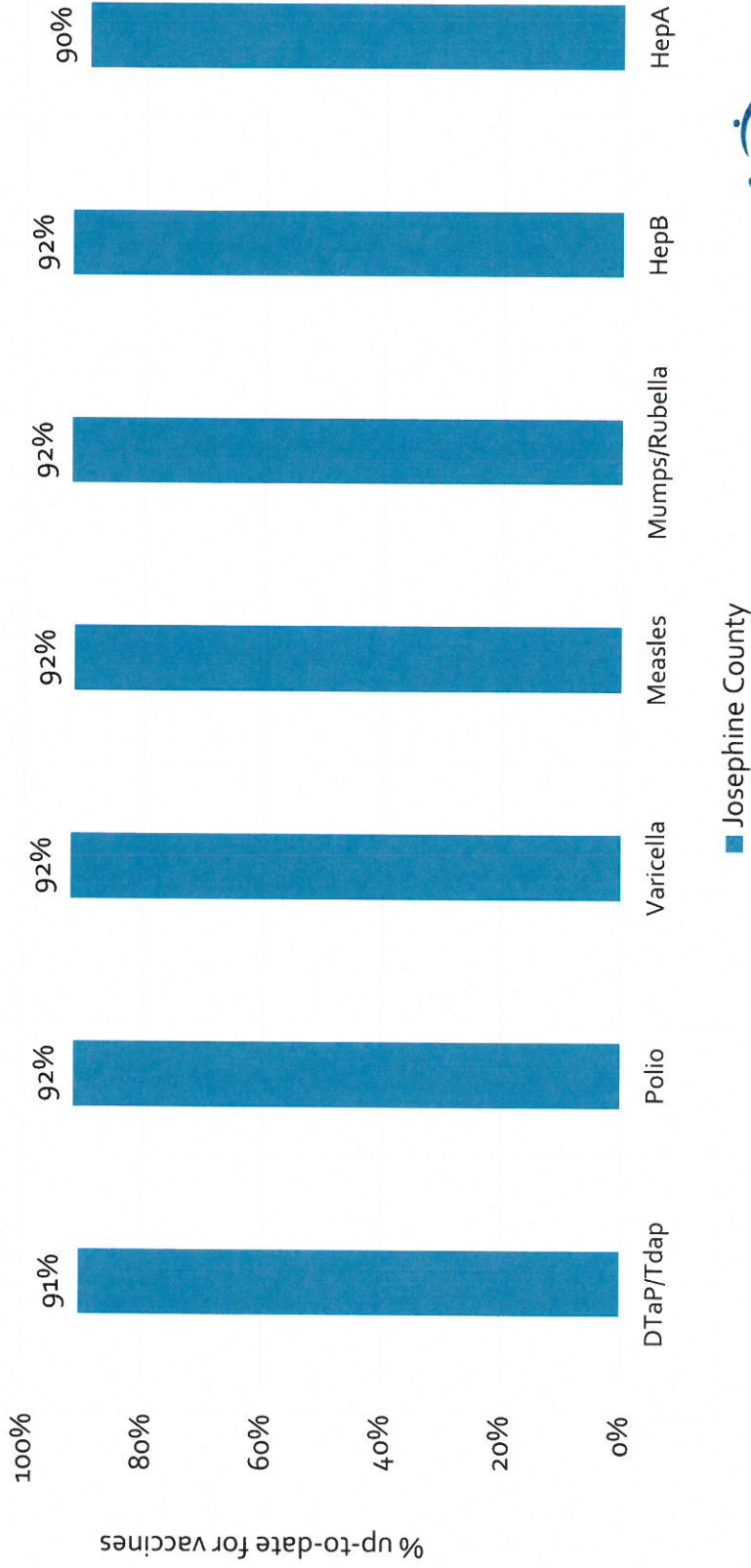
