

RESOLUTION #2017-18-18

Recommended Increases - District Meal Prices for 2018/19

Discussion:

A proposed increase in District Meal Prices for the **2018-19** School year is due to the Federal “Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Act” which reauthorized the National School Lunch Program. This regulation requires the District to increase meal prices to meet Federal Equity Pricing Requirements. Complying with the equity in pricing will necessitate raising Adult Meals.

****Notes: Reduced prices are set by the Federal Government. The State is currently paying the reduced breakfast and reduced lunch price, so for the 2018-19 School year this will remain the same so the district will not need to charge students who are approved for reduced meals.***

Resolution #2017-18-18 APPROVE RECOMMENDED INCREASE IN DISTRICT MEAL PRICES FOR THE 2018-19 SCHOOL YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Federal “Healthy Hunger-Free Food Act” requires the district to increase adult meal prices to meet Federal equity pricing requirements; and WHEREAS, the fixed price for Pattern Meals and Meal Price Equivalents is increasing to offset the continuing increases in the cost of food; therefore
