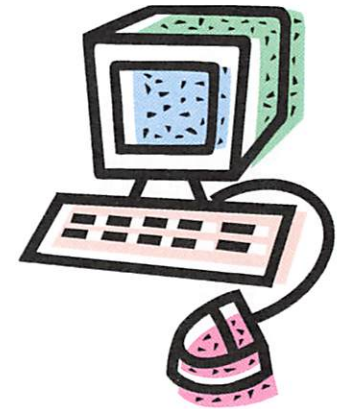


**The following are requirements of
local SHACs per legislation**

Texas Education Code, Chapter 28, Section 28.004:

- ✓ **A parent must serve as the chair or co-chair.**
- ✓ **A minimum of five members must be appointed to serve on the SHAC by the Board of Trustees.**
- ✓ **Majority of members must be parents who are not employees of the district.**
- ✓ **SHAC must meet at least 4 times a year.**
- ✓ **SHAC must deliver an annual report to the Board of Trustees.**
- ✓ **SHAC is required to submit recommendations regarding the districts' health education curriculum.**
