**2. Draft Minutes:** The meeting minutes from January 9, 2026, were approved.

**3. GLVP Course Proposals 2026-27**

Michelle Jaros, Principal of Early College & Innovative Programs, presented the GLVP Course Updates to the Committee; these include new course options along with course descriptions with one title change. Thurn Law has reviewed the updates. The GLVP Course Proposals will be presented to the Board for formal approval.

**4. ELA Materials Review**

Assistant Superintendent Bordner presented the English Language Arts (ELA) Materials Review. During this school year, the district conducted a curriculum review at GLMS and analyzed PSAT data, with a focus on reading, writing, and speaking with purpose.

Professional Development began in August and included a two-day curriculum session led by Tim Hejnal. Throughout the fall, the team engaged in a detailed review of student data and evaluated existing ELA resources, including novels and writing rubrics. This work will continue through Winter 2026, with an emphasis on the evaluation and selection of new instructional materials.

**ADDED ITEM:** Assistant Superintendent Bordner informed the Committee that the Reproductive Health Committee will be meeting in May to discuss the possibility of updating the GLMS materials and textbook. If the textbook is updated, the District is required to hold public forums before board approval.
