INFORMATIONAL REPORT:

The Texas Education Agency’s (TEA) Office of School Safety and Security, in coordination with regional Education Service Centers (ESC), recently conducted an Intruder Detection Audit (IDA) at one or more of the District’s campuses. The IDA tests whether a campus is accessible to an unauthorized individual. The IDA seeks to help school districts identify how campuses can improve safety for students and provide the District an opportunity to create a safer learning environment for students and staff members.

Pursuant to CSA (LEGAL), “Any document or information collected, identified, developed, or produced relating to a safety or security requirement is confidential under Government Code 418.177 and 418.181 (Texas Disaster Act).” Specific details will be discussed in the Board of Trustees’ executive session.
