Dear Families,

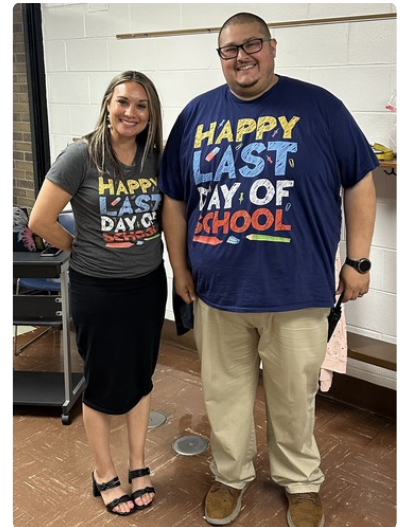

In Math we are finished with Module 7 (geometry) and ending with Module 6 which focuses on measurement and data.

In Science we just wrapped up with Life Cycles and will be ending the year with Animals Through Time.

4th Grade

Hello 4th Grade Families!

As we approach the end of the school year we have so many exciting activities ahead of us. In reading we will be finishing up Unit 7 with a big writing piece about the causes and effects of the American Revolution. In math, we will finish up the year with students building their competencies in measurement as they relate multiplication to the conversion of measurement units. Throughout the module, students explore multiple strategies for solving measurement problems involving unit conversion. In science, we finish our year learning about animal and plant adaptations. We will take a field trip to Brookfield Zoo on June 10th to further our knowledge of animal adaptations.



5th Grade

Hello 5th Grade Families,

As we approach the end of the school year we are thrilled to end our school year with many engaging activities. In literacy students will finish their final book study on the novel "The Science of Breakable Things" by Tae Keller. In math, students will finish the year with Module 6, where they learn about coordinate planes, plotting points, and locating points within the first quadrant of the coordinate plane. In addition, students learn to plot points on the coordinate plane using the x and y coordinates provided.

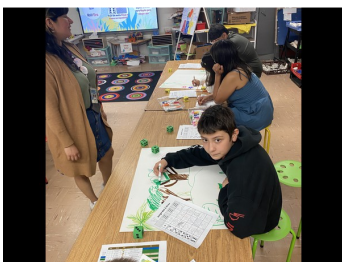

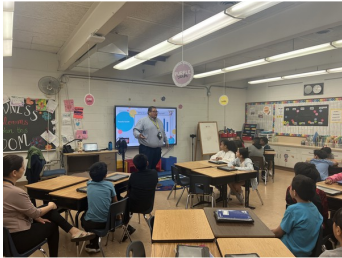


PE

To end the year in SEL/health, we will be doing some fun activities focusing on kindness.

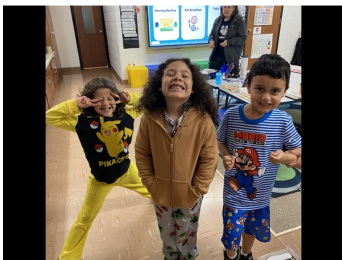


Library
