School Safety:

- Lights: Two Concerns in January regarding the intersection of Bill Baker Way and Fruitdale Drive. Both adults (one parent and one staff member) shared the concern about how dark this intersection was when turning from Fruitdale Drive onto Bill Baker Way. Our district's Maintenance Supervisor was called and walked this portion of the property with Mrs. Yount. There are two street lights on Bill Baker Way which currently are not working. Pro Electric was called to investigate the lighting. The county was also called to discuss this concern as well, inquiring about a street light placed on Bill Baker Way/Fruitdale Drive
- Heat: Maintenance is working on improving the consistency of heat in our building. A project is on-going in this area as they clean out the lines.

Title 1:

- Benchmark Data: Benchmark data shows a consistent increase in the area of Accuracy in reading. This shows that the school-wide Tier III Reading Support Program is working to close the gap with students. The school is making changes this week in moving students around in their intervention groups to best fit their current needs. School staff is very excited about the growth in this area. Other areas of Benchmarks are still collecting data at this time as this is the second week of benchmarking.
- Science Night: School is gearing up for science night. We have several new participants this year, including HVHS Students.

PD/PLC:

- PLC Work continues at Fruitdale. Our school level PD have focused on the new CKLA Textbook adoption and preparing for Essential Standard integration next year. We have spent two PDs on identifying where the majority of instruction of the essential standards naturally occur within the scope and sequence of CKLA. February PD will continue this work as well as focus on grade level strategies to focus on getting fluency practice with CKLA Materials as our Benchmark Data has identified this need school-wide
- PLC Data Meetings (one day a week after school) has continued the grade level focus on math. Teams will revisit Computational Fluency this month as well.

Core Value Work:

- Fruitdale has identified their Core Values through a collaborative process. PAWS (Perseverance, Academic Excellence, Welcoming Environment and Safety) have been identified. A Core Value team has been identified to help with integration into school systems as well as branding ideas.
