# Update on OPEF programs, serving about 4,000 students this year with our FREE programs:

#### Science Alliance:

• Partnerships in 7<sup>th</sup> grade science

#### Geared Up:

- Field trips to Public Works for 3<sup>rd</sup> graders (simple machines) and 7<sup>th</sup> graders (alternative energy, Gold LEED building)
  - Taking advantage of our community's best assets and making more connections for kids

## Art Start:

Project with curricular connections and community involvement

# Architecture Adventure:

- Beloved projects
- Enlisting volunteers a continuing struggle

# **VEX Robotics:**

- Serving 124 students (+28% in 2014-15) and growing percentage of girls (28% in 2014-15, up from 18% in 2013-14)
- · Practices borrowed from business
- PLTW levels and raises the playing field
- Expanding middle school robotics throughout the state

## BASE Camp, our innovation playground:

- Summer and school holiday enrichment in a fun, collaborative environment!
- Served 1,099 kids in 2013-14 -- and growing!
- Fee-based endeavor that helps fund all our free programming during the school year
- New topics with real-world connections (sailing & STEM, Good Food, Video Game Lab, Science Lab, Making 'Zines)
- Hiring and training D97 teachers, hiring HS and college kids as mentors extends our reach
  - 90% of Build<sup>3</sup> Day (MLK Day program) teachers and 100% of "Guides" were D97 staff
  - Summer BASE Camp: 65% of staff are D97 teachers
- New partnership with Park District for Extended Camp to serve working parents
- Granting \$13,000 in scholarships this year
