WHEREAS,	The red ribbon was chosen as a symbol commemorating the work of Enrique "Kiki" Camarena, a Drug Enforcement Administration agent, who was murdered in the line of duty and has come to represent the belief that one person CAN make a difference ; and
WHEREAS,	Clear Creek ISD Board of Trustees asks all teachers, staff, and parents to stand with them to say, "Be the Reason," as part of their commitment to decrease underage drinking.
WHEREAS,	The teachers, staff, students, and parents of Clear Creek Independent School District additionally commit to supporting Red Ribbon Week from October 27, 2025, through October 31, 2025.
