### Important Dates May 3, 2025 School Board of Trustees Election

<b>MAY</b>	<b>3</b>	Deadline to post candidate requirements.
<b>DECEMBER</b>	<b>16</b>	Deadline to post notice of candidate filing deadline.
<b>JANUARY</b>	<b>1</b>	First day to apply for a ballot by mail using Application for a Ballot by Mail (ABBM) or Federal Post Card Application (FPCA).
<b>JANUARY</b>	<b>14</b>	Call for Election; Notice of Election; Order of Election; Order: designating date,time, place, election administrator and early voting date & times.
<b>JANUARY</b>	<b>15</b>	FIRST DAY TO FILE FOR PLACE ON GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT.
<b>FEBRUARY</b>	<b>14</b>	A. LAST DAY TO FILE FOR PLACE ON GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT at 5:00 p.m. B. Last Day to Order General Election
<b>FEBRUARY</b>	<b>18</b>	DEADLINE FOR WRITE-IN CANDIDATES TO FILE DECLARATIONS OF WRITE-IN CANDIDACY - 5:00 P.M.
<b>FEBRUARY</b>	<b>20</b>	First day to post Notice of Drawing for Place on Ballot.
<b>FEBRUARY</b>	<b>21</b>	A. Last day for a candidate to withdraw name from the ballot. B. First Day Election May be Cancelled if Each Candidate has NO opposition.
<b>FEBRUARY</b>	<b>24</b>	Conduct Ballot Position Drawing
<b>MARCH</b>	<b>4</b>	Last day for the governing body of a political subdivision to deliver notice of the election to the county clerk/elections administrator and voter registrar of each county in which the political subdivision is wholly or partly located.
<b>MARCH</b>	<b>19</b>	Deadline to mail (or email, if requested) ballots to military or overseas voters who already submitted their ballot requests via a federal postcard application (FPCA) or via a standard application for ballot by mail (ABBM) and indicated that they are outside the United States.
<b>APRIL</b>	<b>3</b>	A. Last day to register to vote or make a change of address effective for the May 3, 2025 election. B. First day of period during which Notice of Election must be published in a newspaper of general circulation

<b>APRIL</b>	<b>12</b>	Last day to post Notice of Election on bulletin board used for posting notices of meetings of governing body and on an Internet website maintained by the governing body.
<b>APRIL</b>	<b>22</b>	A. FIRST DAY TO VOTE EARLY IN PERSON: 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. B. Last day for early voting clerk to receive applications for a ballot to be voted by mail.
<b>APRIL</b>	<b>23</b>	Early Voting 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
<b>APRIL</b>	<b>24</b>	Early Voting 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
<b>APRIL</b>	<b>25</b>	Early Voting 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
<b>APRIL</b>	<b>28</b>	Early Voting 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
<b>APRIL</b>	<b>29</b>	Last Date to Vote Early In Person 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
<b>MAY</b>	<b>3</b>	ELECTION DAY 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
<b>MAY</b>	<b>6</b>	1st possible day to conduct official canvass of election returns; HOWEVER, the canvass may not be conducted until the ballot board has verified and counted ALL provisional ballots. Notice MUST be posted 72 hours prior to the meeting.
<b>MAY</b>	<b>12</b>	May Regular Board Meeting
<b>MAY</b>	<b>14</b>	Last day for official local canvass of election returns.
<b>JUNE</b>	<b>9</b>	June Regular Board Meeting
