## ADULTS WITH A DEGREE



Twice as likely to vote and volunteer in a civic organization and $\mathbf{3 0 0 \%}$ more likely to donate to charity


Four times less likely to regularly smoke tobacco


Generate additional $\mathbf{\$ 5 3 6 K}$ of tax revenue to the government over their lifetime


Even with longer lifespan at least $\mathbf{\$ 5 0 K}$ less consumption of entitlement or welfare programs
