To meet our needs, a Request for Proposal (RFP) was issued through BuyBoard and TIPS for a Windows laptop that met the following requirements:

14" screen size  
Core Ultra 5 or AMD equivalent  
512 GB NVMe storage  
16 GB DDR5 Ram  
1x HDMI port  
2x USB Thunderbolt or USB4 ports  
1x USB-A

The only vendor to submit a bid was Delcom. They offered the Asus ExpertBook B3 Flip 14" Touchscreen 2-in-1 laptop. This met our minimum requirements and was accepted as the winner of the bid as there were no competitors to evaluate.
