**RE:** IMA AND TEKS CERTIFICATION, 2014-2015

As outlined by new Instructional Materials Allotment (IMA) fund procedures, TEA is requiring districts to certify annually to the State Board of Education and the Commissioner that students have access to instructional materials for each subject in the required curriculum that cover all the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills. Districts will be unable to submit any requisitions or disbursements until the certification has been signed and submitted to the Texas Education Agency. The Instructional Materials Allotment and TEKS Certification form must be presented before the local board of trustees. The superintendent, local board president and the board secretary are required to sign the form before it can be accepted by the Texas Education Agency (TEA).

As a guideline, Eagle Pass ISD only adopts instructional materials that have been reviewed and adopted by the State Board of Education and cover 100% of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for the subject area.
