TASB Policy Update 99

Purpose of Report

Update 99 represents the second of two post-legislative updates, focusing primarily on incorporating changes in law from the 83rd Legislative Session that were not included in Update 98 and recent amendments to the Administrative Code as a result of the recent legislation. Major topics include district legal counsel, safety programs, graduation, credit by examination, and student discrimination and harassment. Update 99 includes 25 legal and 8 local policies of which 2 are recommend for deletion.

Local policies included in Update 99:

- BDD(LOCAL): BOARD INTERNAL ORGANIZATION - ATTORNEY
- BP(LOCAL): ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS
- CFEA(LOCAL): PAYROLL PROCEDURES - SALARY DEDUCTIONS AND REDUCTIONS
- CK(LOCAL): SAFETY PROGRAM/RISK MANAGEMENT
- DAC(LOCAL): EMPLOYMENT OBJECTIVES - OBJECTIVE CRITERIA FOR PERSONNEL DECISIONS
- EHDC(LOCAL): ALTERNATIVE METHODS FOR EARNING CREDIT - CREDIT BY EXAMINATION WITHOUT PRIOR INSTRUCTION
- FFF(LOCAL): STUDENT WELFARE - STUDENT SAFETY
- FFH(LOCAL): STUDENT WELFARE - FREEDOM FROM DISCRIMINATION, HARASSMENT, AND RETALIATION
