# **Executive Summary** Prepared for Board of Trustees Meeting March 25, 2014

## **TASB Policy Update 99**

### Purpose of Report

Update 99 represents the second of two post-legislative updates, focusing primarily on incorporating changes in law from the 83rd Legislative Session that were not included in Update 98 and recent amendments to the Administrative Code as a result of the recent legislation. Major topics include district legal counsel, safety programs, graduation, credit by examination, and student discrimination and harassment. Update 99 includes 25 legal and 8 local policies of which 2 are recommend for deletion.

- DAC(LOCAL): EMPLOYMENT OBJECTIVES OBJECTIVE CRITERIA FOR PERSONNEL DECISIONS
- EHDC(LOCAL): ALTERNATIVE METHODS FOR EARNING CREDIT CREDIT BY EXAMINATION WITHOUT PRIOR INSTRUCTION
- FFF(LOCAL): STUDENT WELFARE STUDENT SAFETY
- FFH(LOCAL): STUDENT WELFARE FREEDOM FROM DISCRIMINATION, HARASSMENT, AND RETALIATION
