Professional Learning Communities (PLC) is an ongoing process in which educators work collaboratively in recurring cycles of collective inquiry and action research to achieve better results for the students they serve. Professional learning communities operate under the assumption that the key to improved learning for students is continuous job-embedded learning for educators. While administrators and teams of teachers have received two trainings this year, more work is to be done in our effort to have functioning PLCs in every school. Jessica and Heather will attend a workshop in which they will receive training by an expert in implementing PLC model across K-12 schools. They will learn about the underlying research and resources that support PLCs from a school and district perspective. They will be equipped with tools and resources to further the PLC work in Three Rivers School District.

Jessica and Heather will increase their understanding of PLC implementation, how it affects academic growth, and how schools can look at data to ultimately have professional conversations to improve daily instruction. The information learned will be shared with other administrators and teacher teams, including the Collaboration Grant.
