## Discussion and consider approval of the Amended Uvalde CISD 2025-2026 Academic Calendar

1. <u>Board goal:1:</u> High Quality Curriculum and Effective Instruction, Domain 2: Effective, Well Supported Staff, Domain 3: Positive School Culture

## 2. Background:

House Bill (HB) 2610, passed by the 84<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature, requires districts to provide a minimum of 75,600 minutes of instruction. The proposed 2025-2026 Academic Calendar meets that requirement.

- 3. <u>Process</u>: Due to the ransomware incident that disrupted instruction during the week of September 15–18, 2025, adjustments to the approved 2025–2026 Academic Calendar are required to ensure compliance with state instructional time requirements and to maintain alignment across reporting cycles. To recover the lost instructional days, the district will utilize previously scheduled closure dates:
- October 31, 2025
- February 6, 2026
- February 9, 2026
- March 6, 2026

This adjustment allows the district to maintain the same number of instructional minutes as originally approved by the Board. Additionally, the grading, reporting, and assessment calendars have been updated to align with the revised academic calendar to ensure coherence across campuses and compliance with TEA requirements. The 2nd calendar is the updated New Hope calendar.
