- 1: The installation of the 3 exhaust fans in the HS welding shop are completed. I have Tongass electric coming to finish up the wiring on them as well as installing a couple of additional 220 volt outlets to help accommodate Mr. Jefferies need for powering some more welding stations. The exhaust fans seem to be removing the exhaust and fine dust particles as expected.
- 2: I was finally able to get Schmolck mechanical over to the island and had the high school boilers cleaned and tuned and are running well. However a fuel pump did go out on 1 of them but the part is on the way. I have cleaned and tuned the other boilers at the other schools and they are ready for the winter season. The tentative plan is to fire up the city wood fired boiler at the beginning of November to heat the elementary and middle schools.

- 3: Our fall state bus inspection was done earlier this month and all buses passed. Thank you Trampus Conatser for making sure they would pass inspection.
- 4: Our new elementary custodian Mr. Colbert has been doing an excellent job and seems to fit in well on the CCSD staff.
- 5: The rest of the month will be continuing getting ready for the oncoming winter such as getting snow removal plans in place, studded tires on district vehicles, etc.

We have our state site visit with Wayne Marquis coming up in November, I of course will not be here for that visit but everything seems to be in order for his arrival and should go well. Our last visit from him went well also.
