

1. What is dual credit? Process allowing students to earn college credit by taking college courses taught by our staff, on our campus.

2. How many dual credit classes do we offer? We currently offer 13 dual credit courses.

3. Are the only two colleges we work with for dual credit Delta State and ICC? Delta State and ICC are the only outside partnerships we have.

4. How many of our classes are with Delta State and what are course names?

We partner with Delta State for 11 courses:

- Biology & Human Concerns (23 enrolled)
- Business Calculus (0 enrolled, This is a bundled class, and students must complete Trigonometry before they can enroll. So, students will be enrolled later in the year.
- College Algebra (173 enrolled)
- English Comp I (103 enrolled)
- English Comp II (103 enrolled)
- Music Appreciation (49 enrolled)
- Statistics (9 enrolled)
- Trigonometry (31 enrolled)
- US History I (64 enrolled)
- US History II (109 enrolled)
- Western Civilization II (9 enrolled)

5. How many of our classes are with ICC and what are course names?

We partner with ICC for 2 Courses:

- British Literature I (111 enrolled)
- British Literature II (112 enrolled)

Both classes are taught by Dr. April Friar.

6. What is the criteria for participation in dual credit classes?

- Junior or Senior
- Minimum GPA: 3.0
- Minimum ACT score: 16

7. What is the cost per dual credit course?

- \$100 per course at ICC
- \$72 per course + one time \$25 application fee at DSU
