- **PBIS:** As we return to school, and the 2020 portion of the school year, students received a reward with a morning movie in the Jr. High Auditorium. They purchased their movie tickets with "star bucks" earned for previous good choice behavior. Additionally, the afternoon was set aside for a boot camp that provided expectation refresher in the zoned areas where we have some room for improvement for the remainder of the school year.
- **Report Cards:** The 2nd quarter ended on December 20, 2019 and report cards were sent home on January 17, 2020. Lincoln Elementary had 176 students obtain the honor roll status.



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- **D.A.R.E.:** The 5th grade team and I have been in contact with D.A.R.E. officer Stephanie Ryan about starting the program for Grade 5 on 1/15/20. She will be visiting the school regularly on Tuesdays and Fridays to work with the students. Drug Abuse Resistance Education (D.A.R.E.) is an education program that seeks to prevent use of controlled drugs, membership in gangs, and violent behavior.
- **MLK:** School was not in session on Monday, January 20th in observance of Martin Luther King day. Teachers have implemented information into the curriculum this month to explain Reverend King's role in the Civil Rights Movement and its effect on our country's history.
- **DATA MEETINGS:** Lincoln Elementary began implementing Rtl meetings based on MAP-RIT scores and progress monitoring data. The Title I teachers have been working hard collecting data to identify student growth, deficits and needs in order to provide the best possible intervention for addressing needs. Developing data sheets are on the agenda for the future in order to document and organize this information cohesively.
- **5 Essential Survey:** Lincoln Elementary students and staff continue to complete the 5 Essential Survey in order to meet the reporting threshold required. Multiple attempts to encourage parents to take the survey are ongoing. The survey deadline is February 15, 2020.
