not liable for any personal injury or damages to personal property related to the nonschool use.

FEES FOR USE

Nonschool users shall be charged a fee for the use of designated facilities.

The Superintendent shall establish and publish a schedule of fees based on the cost of the physical operation of the facilities, as well as any applicable personnel costs for supervision, custodial services, food services, security, and technology services.

The Superintendent reserves the right to waive any fees associated with use of District facilities by nonprofit organizations that are established and that function solely for the benefit of students currently enrolled in the District. This use shall be limited to once per sports season per organization. In specific cases, such as organized league play in which a majority of the participants are students currently enrolled in the District but are separate and apart from the District's organized sports program, the Superintendent shall consider each request and shall determine fees to be assessed.

EXCEPTIONS

Fees shall not be charged when school buildings are used:

1. For public meetings sponsored by state or local governmental agencies; or
2. By District employee professional organizations. [See DGA]

REQUIRED CONDUCT

Persons or groups using school facilities shall:

1. Conduct business in an orderly manner.
2. Abide by all laws and policies, including but not limited to those prohibiting the use, sale, or possession of alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, and firearms, and the use of tobacco products on school property. [See GKA]
3. Make no alteration, temporary or permanent, to school property without prior written consent from the Superintendent.

All groups using school facilities shall be responsible for the cost of repairing any damages incurred during use and shall be required to indemnify the District for the cost of any such repairs.
