Governor's Task Force Recommendations

- These are the recommendations from the Governor's Task Force. As you look at the votes of the committee it is interesting that some legislators voted against some of the recommendations. We'll see how this plays out in the legislative session. While the five recommendations below gained approval, there were other topics that the committee found important and would like to see progress made in some of those areas as well.
 - Statewide accountability focusing on K-3 literacy.
 - Greater all-day kindergarten opportunities to support K-3 literacy and future student achievement.
 - Building out and updating the career ladder salary allocation program to elevate the profession and retain effective educators.
 - Addressing social and emotional issues to support student learning.
 - Strategic alignment and increased flexibility in the K-12 funding formula.
