

Brockett Elementary Goals and Objectives 2015 - 2016

Goal 1: Cultivate a positive learning environment that celebrates success, fosters school pride and spirit, and consistently promotes excellence for today, tomorrow and the future.

- Objective 1: 100% of students at Brockett Elementary will have the opportunity to be recognized for student/school achievement each 9 weeks.
- Objective 2: 100% of grade levels will engage in a career activity, i.e. a field trip that will be connected to the student's lessons.
- Objective 3: Brockett elementary will promote a safe school environment, with 98% of students reporting they feel safe at school.
- Objective 4: 100% of the students and their families at Brockett Elementary will be given the opportunity to participate in academic competition and extracurricular activities.
- Objective 5: Brockett Elementary will foster a positive climate to include 100 % of the faculty and staff while providing support to students and parents.

Goal 2: Support a "whole" student approach to education to prepare students for life.

- Objective 1: All students will achieve 90% mastery on all STAAR tests or maintain 15% above the state average on each test.
- Objective 2: All student populations will maintain 97% attendance.
- Objective 3: Brockett Elementary will provide career education for 100% of the student populations according to the developmental level through the school year.
- Objective 4: Brockett Elementary will develop and implement service projects that will benefit our community and provide opportunities for 100% of the student body to participate
- Objective 5: Brockett Elementary will develop and provide opportunities for 100% of their students to develop leadership, character, and citizenship skills.
- Objective 6: 100% of Brockett Elementary teachers will set individual goals and class goals.
- Objective 7: Brockett Elementary will monitor 100% of the students in transition between grade-level/campuses for ease of student's success.

Goal 3: Continually review growth to ensure district resources support a quality education.

- Objective 1: Brockett Elementary will provide reports monthly to the superintendent or designee the building statistics including, but not limited to enrollment, classroom occupancy, and teacher student ratio.
- Objective 2: Brockett Elementary will work with the Chief Financial Officer and Assistant Superintendent of Buildings to coordinate new developments and projections within the Brockett Elementary Zone quarterly.
- Objective 3: All student populations will be provided cultural awareness education throughout the school year.
- Objective 4: Brockett Elementary will develop a comprehensive Instructional Materials Plan to ensure a quality education for all students.
- Objective 5: In 100% of the classrooms, Brockett Elementary will continue to update technology to include additional software programs, additional technology devices, and increase the number of computers per student to enhance student learning
- Objective 6: As enrollment increases, Brockett Elementary will research the need for additional support programs to maintain 90% or greater success rate at each grade level.
- Objective 7: 100% of teachers recruited, hired, and retained are highly qualified.

Goal 4: Proactively communicate through a variety of media with parents and the community to encourage involvement and partnership in education.

Objective 1: 100% of Brockett Elementary teachers will communicate with parents weekly through at least one form of electronic media.

Objective 2: At least 90% of parents at Brockett Elementary will be signed up for Parent Portal.

Objective 3: Brockett Elementary will hold at least one site based decision making meeting per semester with 90-100% participation of the team.

Objective 4: 100% of the parents will be provided opportunities to receive information / training on electronic resources used by children at Brockett.

Goal 5: Ensure professional growth for leadership and staff.

Objective 1: All teachers will attend a minimum of four hours of technology training either during the school year or for an in-lieu day.

Objective 2: 100% of Brockett Elementary teachers will be trained on the use of parent communication tools.

Objective 3: 100% of Brockett Elementary teaching faculty and staff will be trained in Special Education Process, RTI, SST, 504, G/T, STAAR Testing, and ARD Decision Making.

Objective 4: 100% of all new teachers will attend the AISD New Teacher Academy.

Objective 5: All teachers will be provided support and professional development to learn the new math TEKS and promote 90% and greater of student success on the Math STAAR Assessment.
