MTSS is...

a responsive framework that provides instruction, interventions, and supports intended to meet the needs of the whole child (academic, behavioral, physical, social, and emotional). Based on an aligned curriculum, the core instruction, interventions and supports are organized along a continuum to meet the needs of each and every learner. Intervention tiers are intended to be layered with intensification of supports as matched to learner need.

MTSS TIERS

TIER 1

The evidence-based core curriculum and classroom interventions that will be available to all learners and effectively meet the needs of most students.

Classroom instruction should effectively educate at least 80% of all students.

<u>Tier 1 Interventions:</u> Differentiated instruction or instructional strategies/activities implemented by the classroom teacher during classroom instruction.

TIER 2

Supplemental, targeted group interventions intended for some learners who require support beyond tier 1.

Push in or pull out services provided typically by a classroom teacher and/or interventionist not during core instruction, for a period of up to 20 weeks, with progress monitoring.

TIER 3

Supports provide intense individual interventions for few learners with exceptional or severe and persistent academic and/or non-academic needs.

Intense, individualized, daily interventions often provided by a math specialist, reading specialist, interventionists, or special education educator.

Supports and interventions increase in frequency and intensity.
