- The Property Casualty Alliance of Texas (PCAT) hereby agrees to extend current funding levels, with no rate increase, through 9/1/2007 for Keller Independent School District (KISD).
- Furthermore, PCAT hereby agrees to offer a <u>rate renewal of no more than 10% for the 2007</u> – 2008 Participation Period.
- PCAT hereby agrees to offer a 10% wind/hail Deductible Credit for each year KISD has been claim-free from wind/hail claims as of 9/1/2006, up to a maximum credit of 30%. This Deductible Credit will apply for the 2006–2007 Participation Period only.
- 4. If KISD provides notice of cancellation as provided by Article 3 of the PCAT Interlocal Agreement, prior to 9/1/2007, a short-term cancellation penalty of ten percent (10%) of Annual Contributions for the 2005-2006 and 2006-2007 Participation Period will be due from KISD and payable to PCAT within 30 days after notice is received.
- This Interlocal Agreement Addendum along with the original Interlocal Agreement, signed on 4/14/2003, and any other Addendums, shall represent the entire agreement and may not be amended or altered without the written consent of both parties.
- The rates for the 2006-2007 and 2007-2008 Participation Period will be applied to the exposures in effect during that time, such as building and contents values, number of autos and number of students.
