- Progress can be seen by the chart
- Board should be advised at the highest level
- Changes in strategy always need to go to the board

Strategic Plan Update: Board Improvement

Current inputs/support :

- Will review and approve at the next Board meeting

Future inputs/support:

- Survey to support needed systems, “where do rubs occur”
- Stakeholder event support upon need

School Board Role for Review

- Valuable Final Product: Did the School Board do their job?
- Sub Products of the Role from Stakeholder Perspective: If we are doing it right this is what our Stakeholders experience.
- Additional Products: (Sub Products) – These support the Valuable Final Product.
- Role Authorities: Boundaries of the board, an example is the board does not have the authority to manage district employees, just the superintendent.
- Input – Value Add – Product Table: Identifies the needs to do the work so that the product can be achieved.
- Performance Areas: Data that demonstrates that the job is being done or that progress is being made.

Successful Role Implementation

- Used as a working document and not put on a shelf

- Used for support and not punitive
- Understood by internal stakeholders so they are able to support the role
