Increase the percentage of 3rd grade students who score Master's level performance on STAAR Math by 37% by December 31, 2027.


Goal 3 (CCMR)

GPM 1.2: The percentage of Kindergarten - 2nd grade students meeting the literacy composite benchmark will increase by 30%.




Goal 2 (Math)

Fall 2024 vs. Spring 2025




Goal 3 (CCMR)
