State Forensics

Congratulations to the Forensics team on its outstanding season. The team had 14 participants, which equated to 6 competition entries. 11 participants and 4 entries qualified for the state competition. Frederic's state competitors earned scores of 22, 23, 24, and 25. Each entry earned either a bronze, silver, or gold medal.



Regional Education Pathways Maps

Our CTE staff have been working with CESA 1, in partnership with the Great Northwest regional economic development organization, to develop Regional Career Pathway Maps representing the following areas:

- Business Administration - Business Management
- Business Administration - Finance
- Advanced Manufacturing
- Architecture & Construction

Future targeted maps include Agriculture and Digital Technology. The goal of the process is to build tools personalized to our school district that will help students, staff, families, and employers better see a clear pathway to a career. Once the pathways are officially approved, they can be promoted for the information they provide, but also help develop opportunities to build community partnerships and work-based learning programs. The maps will be updated yearly.

High School Ranking

The high school was recently ranked in the annual US News and World Report Best High Schools. Frederic is ranked #109 out of 452 Wisconsin high schools and #3,675 out of 17,840 high schools nationally. The school was given an overall score of 79.4/100. Factors considered for ranking include AP exams, math, reading, and science proficiencies, and graduation rate.

Statewide Referendum Results

A total of 55 districts across the state passed 65 referendum questions. This represented an 80% pass rate, as 70 districts asked 81 questions.

- 5 of 8 recurring passed
- 35 of 38 non-recurring passed
- 25 of 35 debt issuance passed

The statewide approved referendums represent \$864 million.
