Terrell ISD currently has active memberships in 22 purchasing cooperatives. The EPCNT (Educational Purchasing Cooperative of North Texas) Purchasing Cooperative recently updated the interlocal agreement to reflect the new managing partner for the cooperative.

Terrell ISD is currently a member of the EPCNT and due to this update, needs to sign a new agreement with this cooperative.

The EPCNT Purchasing Cooperative consists of school districts located in Region 10 and Region 11 that allows each district to utilize an existing bid from one of the member districts. Membership with this cooperative saves valuable time and resources when needing to make purchases.
