Background Information

Texas law ([Texas Education Code, Title 2, Subtitle F, Chapter 28, Subchapter A, §28.004](#)) requires the establishment of a SHAC for every school district. SHACs are required to meet at least four times each year. The Midway ISD School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) met on October 15, 2025, December 10, 2025, February 18, 2026, and April 15, 2026. SHACs are required to submit an annual report to the board of trustees. The meeting reports, communicated as recommendations, are below.

- Continue to promote mental and physical wellness for staff and students on all campuses
- Continue vaping awareness and education, fentanyl awareness and education, and other substance use education through VIP events, PE, guidance lessons and health courses
