The Oregon Department of Education Administrative review for food service was April 5th-7th, 2016. Jennifer Parenteau from ODE was the reviewer. The districts previous review was April 2013, with Jennifer, Autumn Morgan, and Kim Putman. 2012-13 was the first year of menu certification with the HHFKA (Healthy Hunger-Free Kid's Act). Reviews are completed every 3 years.

Areas reviewed are: Free and reduced applications, menus, production sheets, food labels and proper crediting of food, recipes which show the crediting of meal components, safety program, wellness committee and wellness policy, civil rights procedures, procurement, meal prices, lunch supervision by district staff, food security, compliancy with the food management company and who does what paperwork (district or Sodexo), SMART snacks (district vending machines and fundraisers sold to students), and observing kitchen staff and making sure they know meal patterns, reimbursable meals, and civil rights, policies and procedures, and to make sure professional standards (training) are met.

NO financial sanctions were documented and the review was a success.
