MEETING DATE: March 20, 2023

AGENDA ITEM: Consider Approval of Missed School Day Waiver

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Districts or campuses may request a waiver for excused absences if instructional days are missed due to inclement weather issues, health, safety-related, or other issues. If because of weather, safety, or health issues, a district misses additional instructional days beyond two days made up using built in or additional minutes or days, the school district may apply to the Texas Education Agency for a Missed School Day Waiver.
- McCall Elementary and Daniel Ninth Grade campuses were closed on Friday, March 3, 2023, due to inclement weather causing power outages at both campuses.
- Districts are required to make up two days' worth of minutes prior to requesting a Missed School Day Waiver. AISD met that requirement on January 30 and 31, 2023.
- Aledo ISD would like to apply for a TEA Missed School Day Waiver for March 3, 2023, for McCall Elementary and Daniel Ninth Grade.
