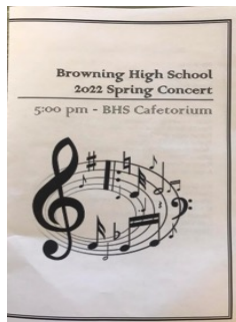
ACT – Online

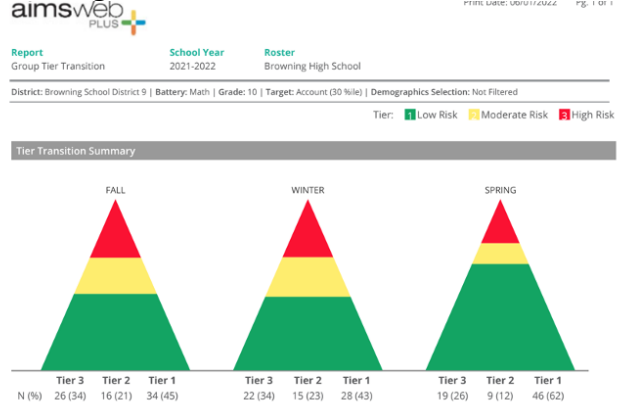
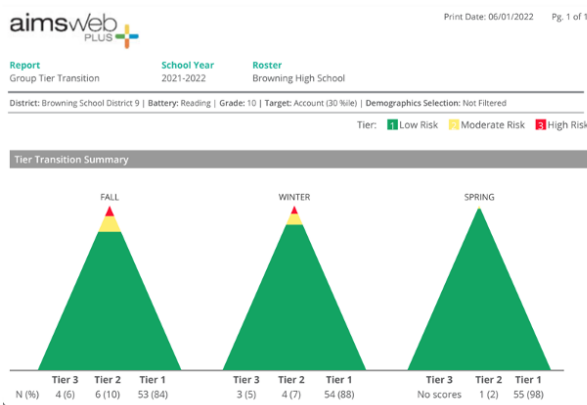
Year End Data

Our implementation plans helped to increase our aimswebPLUS scores from Fall to Spring throughout the grades in both reading and math

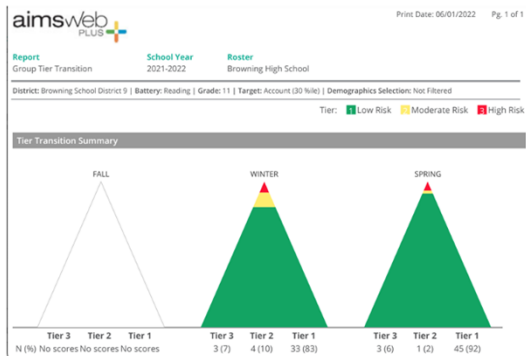
Grade 9 - Reading/ Math



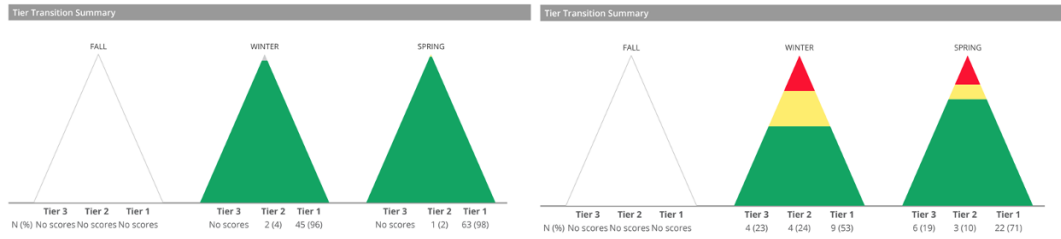
Grade 10 - Reading/ Math
