7. ACTION ITEMS

7.a. Consider Approval of 2025-2026 Budget - Mary Brown

Administration presented and asked for approval for the 2025-2026 budgets. The budgets

presented were the Debt Service Fund Budget, Food Service Fund Budget and the General Fund

Budget (which includes the State Comp Ed Budget). The 2025-2026 Compensation Package was

approved at the July regular board meeting.

Matt Folmar made a motion to approve the 2025-2026 Budgets as presented. Dale Haney seconded the motion and it passed unanimously (7-0)

7.b. Consider Approval of Ordinance for 2025-2026 Hallsville ISD M&O and I&S Tax Rates - Mary Brown

Administration recommended approval of the 2025-2026 Tax Rates. The recommended rates are \$0.6822 for M&O and \$0.095 for I&S funds, which is a decrease from the 2024-2025 M&O tax rate of \$0.6832 and no change from the 2024-2025 tax rate of \$0.095.

Troy Crafton made a motion that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of the tax rate of \$0.7772, which is effectively a 2.70 percent increase in the tax rate. This motion to adopt an ordinance, resolution, or order setting the tax rate requires language about "tax increase" as stated in Section 26.05(b) of Property Tax Code. Shane Goswick seconded the motion and it passed unanimously (7-0)



7.c. Consider Approval of the Bobcat Stadium Parking Lot Expansion - Mary Brown Administration requested approval to move forward with the design of the parking lot revisions at Bobcat Stadium.

Doug McGarvey made a motion to move forward with the parking lot design as presented. Dale Haney seconded the motion and it passed unanimously (7-0)

7.d. Consider Approval of Vendor Over \$50,000 (Title I Services for Stride/K12) - Mary Brown Administration requested approval to pay Title I grant expenditures totaling \$339,878.69 for the TVAH campus. This (2024-2025) is the first year that the TVAH campus qualified as a Title I campus.

Troy Crafton made a motion to approve the payment for Title I services for TVAH as presented. Jason Ainsworth seconded the motion and it passed unanimously (7-0)

7.e. Consider Approval of Vendor Over \$50,000 (Magic School AI) - Amy Whittle Administration requested approval to purchase Magic School AI, which is an AI platform built exclusively for education. TVAH is requesting this platform, which includes access for 20,000 students. Magic School AI is already being used by some of our brick and mortar campuses within the district. The \$95,000 will come from Title funds.

Dale Haney made a motion to approve Magic School AI as presented. Shane Goswick seconded the motion and it passed unanimously (7-0)

7.f. Consider Approval of Vendor Over \$50,000 (Texas Multi-Chem) for Softball Complex Netting - Matt Tucker

Administration requested approval to replace the backstop netting at the softball complex. The \$67,200 project will be funded from the General Fund, and the recommended vendor is Texas Multi-Chem.

Troy Crafton made a motion to approve the softball netting project as presented. Matt Folmar seconded the motion and it passed unanimously (7-0)
