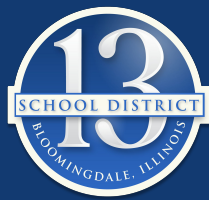

Shared Goal Statement



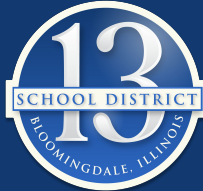

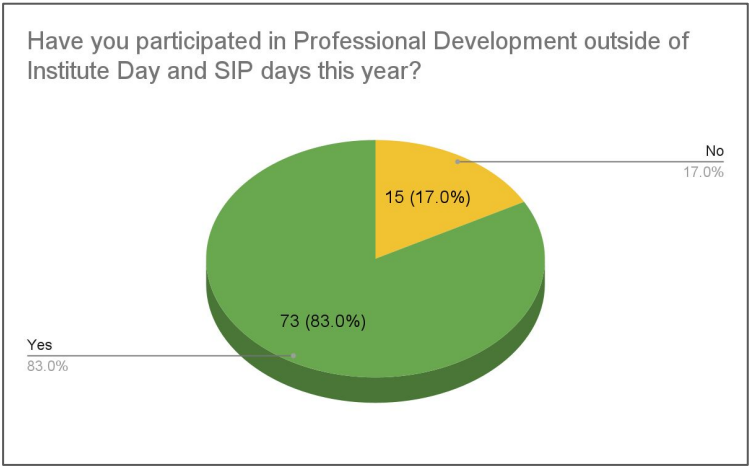

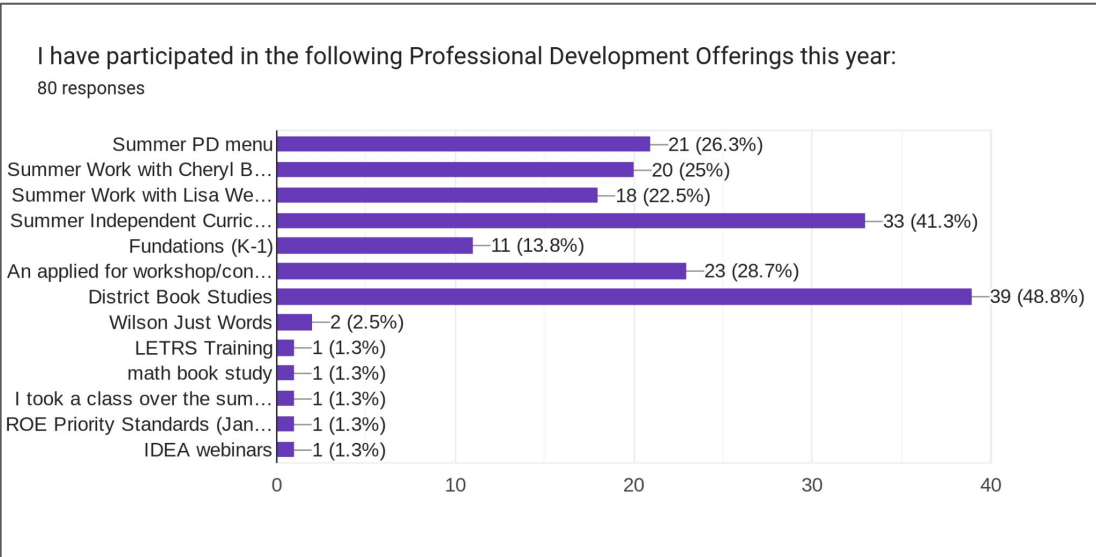
August 2022-December 2022 Professional Development



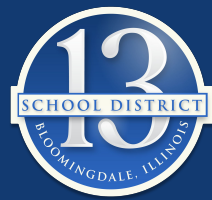
83% of staff surveyed participated in elective professional development
