BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Per section 28.004 of the Texas Education Code, "The board of trustees of each school district shall establish a local school health advisory council to assist the district in ensuring that local community values are reflected in the district's health education instruction."
- Section 28.004 of the Texas Education Code additionally states, "In addition to performing other duties, the local school health advisory council shall submit to the board of trustees, at least annually, a written report."
- The Aledo ISD school health advisory council met five times during the 2019-2020 school year on October 7, November 11, February 3, March 9, and May 4
- The Aledo ISD school health advisory council consists of 31 campus-based voting members, which include 17 parents, 10 staff, and 4 students. The membership is also comprised of 8 non-voting members which include 4 district-level staff and 4 community representatives.
