



**GOVERNING BOARD AGENDA ITEM
AMPHITHEATER UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 10**

DATE OF MEETING: July 10, 2018

TITLE: Selection of Governing Board Delegate and Alternate for Arizona School Board Association (ASBA) Delegate Assembly; Determination of Governing Board Position on ASBA Legislative Action Agenda Items; Direction to Delegate and Alternate

BACKGROUND:

The Arizona School Boards Association (ASBA), of which the Governing Board is a member board, is holding its annual ASBA Delegate Assembly on September 8, 2018. The Delegate Assembly determines ASBA's positions for any future Special Sessions of the current legislature and for the first regular session of the Fifty-Fourth Legislature.

In advance of the September Delegate Assembly, ASBA requested that individual Governing Boards review its 2018 Political Agenda, as compiled at its 2017 annual meeting. From the Agenda, ASBA asked each Board to affirm its top five (5) priorities and then select up to two (2) additional priorities for consideration by the ASBA Legislative Committee.

Amphitheater's Board studied the Agenda at its meeting of May 1, 2018 and provided direction on its recommended priorities. The submitted items were compiled from across Arizona and then discussed by ASBA's Legislative Committee to create a draft document of advocacy positions on issues of concern through the State. This draft document will be the basis for discussion at the official Delegate Assembly on September 8th.

At the time this Board item was initially prepared, the draft ASBA Legislative Agenda had not yet been distributed to the member districts. This item is expected to be amended with that information prior to this Board meeting.

While all superintendents and governing board members from member districts are invited to and may participate in the discussions held during the Assembly, each member district is only permitted one vote on each matter presented to the assembly for a vote. Thus, one component of this item is the selection of the Board's official and voting delegate to the assembly. The Board is also advised to select an alternate delegate who would be authorized to attend the assembly, along with the delegate, and to vote in the event the delegate was unable to do so for some reason.

After doing so, the Board may, through discussion and/or motion, direct the delegate and alternate delegate how to vote or otherwise represent the interests of the Board in the development of the official ASBA political agenda.


RECOMMENDATION:

This Administration recommends that the Governing Board:

1. Appoint a delegate from the Board membership to attend the September 8, 2018 ASBA Legislative Conference and Delegate Assembly and vote on behalf of the Board;
2. Appoint an alternate delegate from the Board membership to attend the ASBA Legislative Conference and Delegate Assembly and, in the absence of the delegate, vote on behalf of the Board; and

3. Provide direction, as it determines, to the delegate and alternate delegate on legislative matters of concern to the Board and/or provide direction on how the delegate or alternate delegate should vote on matters.
