

Report for June 2025

We are a few steps closer to having the **ARPA Pole Barn** project finished. At this point, our punch list is limited to shelving in the storage areas and turning over the keys. We received our occupancy permit by the end of June and I moved the busses in on July 1. Our mechanic informed me that we will likely extend the life of our big bus by several years now that we are storing it inside.



Our 6th **Annual Car Show** was a huge success! We had 65 cars, 146 registered spectators and the best weather imaginable. We were able to give away \$6,081.22 in prizes/raffles and raise \$5,456.49 to help offset the Senior Center expenses. Comments were extremely favorable and we were encouraged to host #7 next June.



The **job posting for an Assistant Director** produced three applicants from Clio. They range in age and abilities and will be (were, by the time you read this) interviewed on July 7th. All three have ties to the Center and should have some insight into what we do and hopefully have suggestions on programming ideas to expand our circle of influence. At the time that I am writing this, it is pre-interview; but I'm assuming (hoping) that one will rise to the top and will be presented before you on July 14th.

The distribution of **Senior Project Fresh coupons** is going rather slowly this year. The roll-out took several weeks longer than anticipated, but we were given the "go-ahead" on June 18th. There are new application procedures which have greatly curbed the participation. Applicants now need an email address and a way of tracking an electronic card. My staff is ready and willing to help any local (60+, Genesee County, low-income) person or farmer with the application if asked.
