
Building, Grounds, and Infrastructure

School Celebrations

Three NMS student athletes placed at the IESA State Track Meet held on May 23-24 in Peoria, Illinois, this year. In the 3A division, Sophie Nelson took third in the long jump. Sam Rendtorff finished 10th in the 100m dash, 20th in the shot put, second in long jump and 11th in 200m dash. Kayla Shea placed fourth in the discus throw. We are incredibly proud of all three athletes!

NMS sent 13 students to the FPS International Conference at Indiana University from June 4-June 8. At the conference, the students competed against teams from 30 states and 11 countries. The topic of the competition was The Future of History. We did have a team place in the top 14 (out of 72 teams) for the presentation portion of the competition. Our students had a chance to interact with people from these different places through a variety of social events, including a Memento exchange, a variety show, and a dance. Along with the opportunity to stay on a college campus for the duration of the conference, it was a rewarding experience for all involved.
