From the Will of Mr. Edwin Sweetman:

The income shall be used for scholarships at the University of Minnesota to be awarded to graduates of the Public High Schools of Aitkin, Minnesota. Said candidates for said scholarships shall be selected by a non-compensated committee consisting of the Superintendent of Schools and members of the public high school of Aitkin, Minnesota faculty. The selection of the candidates for scholarships shall be on the basis of the highest scholastic ratings. Such awards shall be made to two graduates; the highest scholastic ranking graduate, and to the second highest scholastic ranking graduate. The amount of such scholarships shall be \$10,000.00 to the first highest ranking graduate and \$6,250.00 to the second highest ranking graduate. The amount of the scholarships may be increased or decreased depending upon the income that may be derived from said fund. If a candidate should refuse for any reason, to accept such scholarship, the scholarship shall then be offered to the next highest ranking graduate or graduates on the same basis respectively. Any income not consumed because of failure of such recipient to complete his four-year studies, or by reason to "drop out" shall be added to the principal of the scholarship fund. The Scholarship Committee shall confer with the University and the recipients as to the course of study to be pursued and the candidates aptitude as to such course.
