## Background Information:

- The 2005 Bond developed the site at Keller Hicks and Alta Vista for a new Middle and Intermediate campus.
- As part of this development, a public drainage way was incorporated into the site for surface runoff into the Little Bear Creek system.

## Administrative Considerations:

• With the completion of the drainage study and site development, additional area is required for the on-site surface drainage system. To preserve this area for its intended purpose, the easement must be modified with the addition of the attached easement document.

The administration recommends the approval of the easement on the Trinity Springs Middle and Trinity Meadows Intermediate site to accommodate site drainage as designed by the City of Fort Worth and Teague Nall & Perkins Engineers.
