Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the Third Reporting Period, (November 10, 2014 – December 19, 2014). Along with the fall attendance figures (August 25, 2014 – December 19, 2014).

Objectives

- District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report.
- Attendance figures are based on 25 days (November 10 December 19).
- Semester total is based on 78 days (August 25 December 19).

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for the Third Reporting Period is 95.46%.
- The lowest total attendance averages are for Pre-K at 90.84% followed by 12th graders at 93.94%
- The highest attendance averages are in the 5th grade at 96.12% followed by 4th at 96.02%.
- The 2014 fall semester average is 96.34%

Comparison: 2012's third grading cycle was 95.79%.

2013's third grading cycle was 96.22%

Semester Comparison: 2012 Fall 96.49%
