III. REVIEW OF THE 2023-2024 BUDGET

Superintendent of Schools Dr. Ken Craw spoke of the upcoming budget for 2023-2024. He thanked the district administrators for their help in compiling answers to questions sent to the district.

Dr. Craw spoke of enrollment projections for each school. He noted that percentage increase of the budget is higher than previous years and explained that it is due to inflation, extra needs due to the pandemic and the expiration of many ESSER and ARPA funds. He noted that the requested budget increase is similar to increases of surrounding towns. Dr. Craw spoke of projected enrollment and the staffing plan for each school which includes teachers, coaches and interventionists. It was noted that the secretarial staff for the Athletic Director was reduced.

Pupil Personnel Director Katherine Matz spoke of possible grants for the district and gave a brief description of the application process.

The next Budget meeting of the BOE will be held on Wednesday, January 25th at 7:00 via Zoom. Main topics that will be discussed include the budget for Curriculum, Technology, and Central Office.
