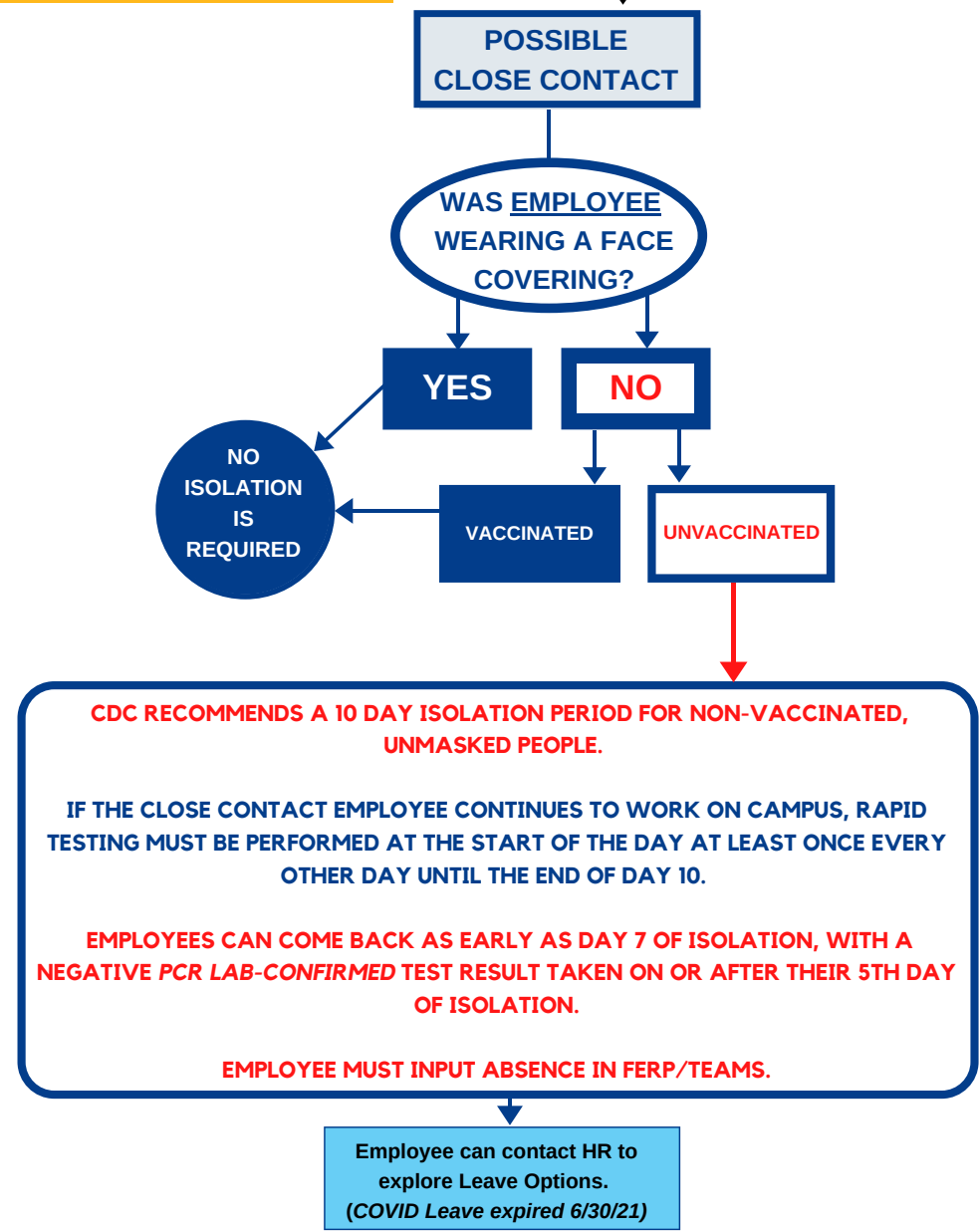
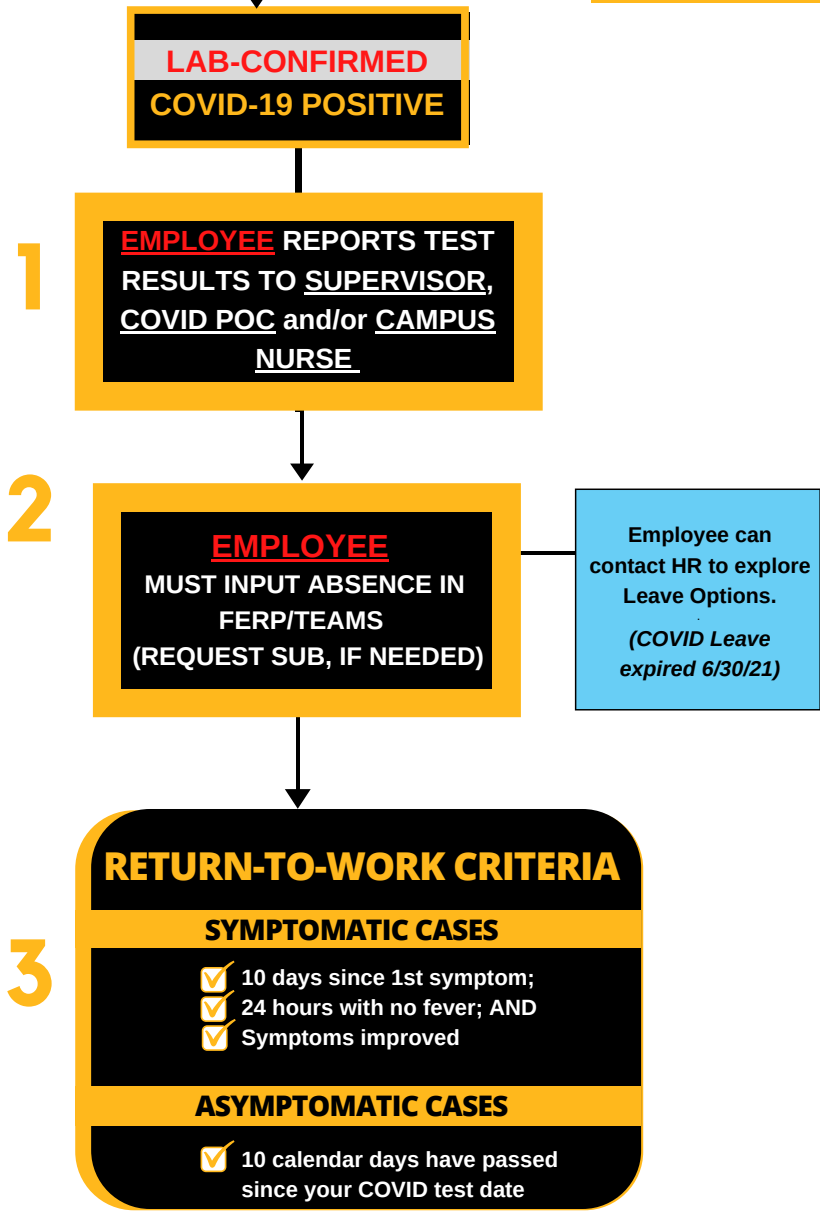


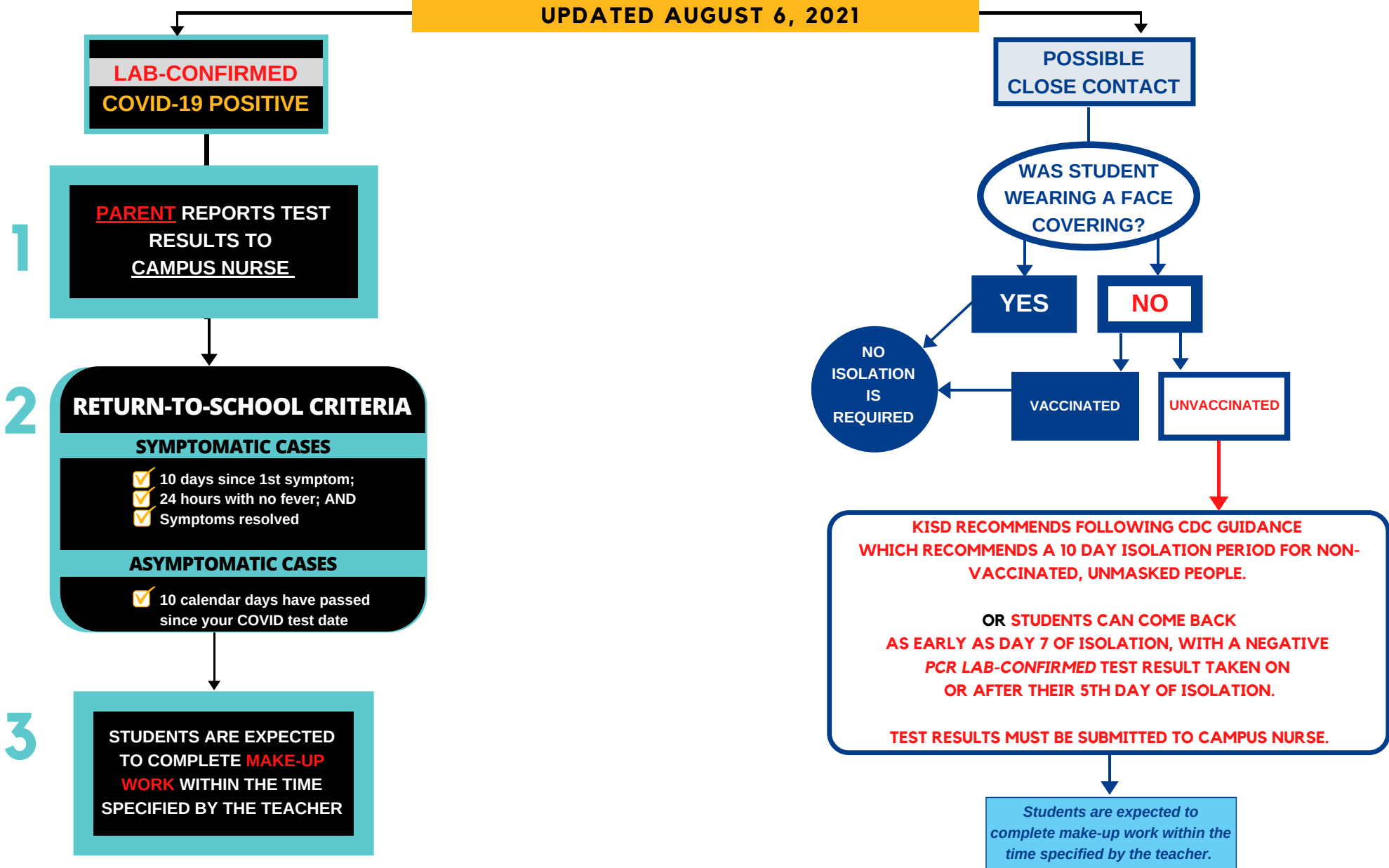
KISD COVID-19 EMPLOYEE FLOWCHART

PROBABLE
POSITIVE

The individual may choose to get a lab-confirmed PCR COVID-19 test.

The CDC recommends isolating until all of the following are met:

1. 10 days since symptoms first appeared and
2. 24 hours with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and
3. Other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving

If the individual gets a PCR lab-confirmed test, they must report it to the campus or department.

If lab-confirmed positive, the individual must meet the return to work/school criteria to be allowed back onto KISD property.

Each rapid screener is automatically reported to the Department of State Health Services (DSHS), through the QR Code. DSHS tracks probable cases on their public dashboard.

This case will not be reflected on the KISD COVID-19 Dashboard.

NEGATIVE
RESULT

The individual may return to work or school.

If symptoms not improving or are worsening, get a PCR COVID test or call your doctor.

If the person loses their sense of taste or smell, they should get a PCR test.

It is strongly recommended for the individual to wear a face covering.
